# 20 years of precision with passion – Audi Hungaria Tool Factory celebrates its anniversary

- The Győr-based Tool Factory has been a technological centre of premium car manufacturing for 20 years
- More than 3 million body parts and 3,200 press tools
- · Precision solutions for future electric models will also come from Győr

Győr, 15 October 2025 – Audi Hungaria Tool Factory celebrates its 20th anniversary this year. To mark the anniversary, the company looked back to its beginnings and presented how the Győr plant has become one of the largest and most innovative tool factories in Central and Eastern Europe. The history of the Tool Factory has been and will continue to be about knowledge, continuous development and shared success – and it will continue to follow this path in the future as well.

In 2005, the Audi Hungaria Tool Factory started out on 18,000 m² with 185 employees. Since then, more than 3 million automotive body parts, 3,200 press tools and 5,500 assembly appliances and equipment have been produced here with unrivalled precision. Over the years, the three pillars of the tooling factory – exclusive series production of body parts, tooling, and appliance and equipment manufacturing – have reached their full potential in projects related to low-volume vehicle models. The body parts for the Audi R8, Lamborghini Hurracan, Bentley and Audi e-tron GT have all been made in Győr.

"The Tool Factory is the technological flagship of Audi Hungaria. The knowledge and dedication of the highly skilled professional community working here enables us to offer world-class solutions to our partners," said Michael Breme, Chairman of the Board of Management of Audi Hungaria.

Throughout its history, the Tool Factory has been constantly expanding: new halls, production equipment, such as high-performance presses, have been added to the 58,300 m<sup>2</sup> plant. In addition to production competences, the necessary expertise in maintenance, quality assurance, logistics and project management has been developed.

"For us, precision is not just a goal, it's our passion. The results of the past 20 years, the many vehicle projects that have been implemented, prove that the highest level of press tool, equipment and exclusive component manufacturing is available in Győr, and will continue to be so in the future. This is guaranteed by the knowledge of our more than 500 employees," said Zoltán Les, Member of the Board of Management of Audi Hungaria responsible for Vehicle Production.
